

Brain Structure, Anorexia Nervosa and Masking in Autism: Seeking Participants!

About the Study

We are inviting **Autistic individuals** with living experience of **anorexia nervosa (AN)** to take part in a study investigating the relationship between brain structure, eating disorder symptoms and masking behaviour.



What Does the Study Involve?

We are asking individuals to undergo an **MRI scan*** of the brain and complete a series of questionnaires, in total lasting about **3 hours**. Scan the **QR code** to complete an online screener for study participation.



Inclusion Criteria

You may be eligible to participate in this study if:

- You are between **25-45 years old**
- You are **Autistic** (clinically diagnosed)
- You have living experience of **anorexia nervosa**
- You have **no history** of trauma affecting the brain
- You have **no contraindication** to MRI
